The interview was conducted by Special Agent (SA) [redacted] Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS), and SA [redacted] Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). [redacted] provided English to Arabic translation during the interview. [redacted] provided the following information.

[redacted] denied being able to speak or understand the English language. [redacted] indicated that he was in good health, however was bored with the food that he was receiving. Additionally, he requested that his Koran be taken from him. He indicated that he has memorized the entire book and does not want it in his cell. He stated that he does not want the book because the possibility of an (infidel) MP touching it exists if he has it in his cell. When asked to recite his favorite Sura's from the Koran he was

not able to do so. He cited his favorite topics covered in the Sura's. [redacted] compared Camp Delta to any prison in [redacted] any other Arab country and indicated that Camp Delta was the worst prison in which to be detained. When asked if he was ever incarcerated in [redacted] he stated that he was not. He later clarified [redacted]

[redacted] then began to complain about the conditions at Camp Delta, stating that the new MP's with the 9/4 patch on their shoulders were mistreating the detainees. He stated that he was not allowed to talk to other detainees in his cell block by these MP's. [redacted] also believed that his letters are being withheld from him, stating that he has written his family over 100 letters but only received 4 letters in reply.

[redacted] was told about Camp Four and asked if he knew how he could be moved to Camp Four. He had heard of it and saw the photographs that were posted in the interview rooms, but stated that it can be called "Camp Four", however it is still a prison.

When asked if he thought he deserved to leave Camp Delta, [redacted] sarcastically replied "no". He then told SA [redacted] to ask him why (stating why in English). His response to his own question was "because I'm Muslim", again stated in English. He opined that this war (in Afghanistan) was Christianity and Judaism against Islam. [redacted] believes that he was "kidnaped" by [redacted] who were working for America, and brought to Camp Delta. He further believes that it was God's will that he come into US custody and that he will be released when it is God's will in the same manner that he was "kidnaped".

He then asked for any news [redacted] He stated that the last news he received [redacted] [redacted] he stated that he was not sure. He further stated that he was not involved in [redacted] He stated that this allegation was false. When asked why [redacted] would lie he indicated that it was because they were also infidels who were "slaves" to the Americans.

[redacted] then indicated that he obtained a lot of his views about Israel and Jewish people from the Prophet Mohammed. He indicated that the Prophet stated that "one day the Muslims will kill all the Jews in Palestine. All will be killed until even the trees that a Jew were to hide behind would talk and tell everyone that there was a Jew hiding behind him."

When asked what he thought his life plans would have been had he not been detained, he indicated that he would have married, had children, and perhaps gone back to school to study Islam and Islamic laws. He was not able to give any long-term plans and stated that it is "Allah's will" as to what will become of his life. If he were to ever be released from Camp De ta he stated that he would get married have children and teach Islam.

[redacted] indicated that he does not hate Americans or the US. He opined that the US will eventually enter into a war with Yemen, just because they can. He opined that the US will be at war with Syria and Iran next [redacted] He stated that he obtained his news from other detainees who obtained their news from their interviewers. When asked who he obtained his news from, he stated that he was not a spy and did not want to identify which detainee provided him with the news. [redacted] agreed to meet with and talk to interviewing agents in the future. At this point the interview was terminated.

The interview was conducted [redacted] with translation provided by SGT [redacted]. After explaining the purpose of the interview [redacted] provided the following information:

The interview on 5/8/03 of [redacted] was conducted at 1530 and was completed at 1830. The interview on 5/9/03 was conducted at 0400 and concluded at 0645. These two interviews are linked together, with the second a continuation of the first.

Observed during these interviews, [redacted] was fully engaged. [redacted] maintained excellent eye contact with the interview team. [redacted] laughed and joked at times with the interview team. [redacted] appeared to very concerned about the evidence which was presented to him. [redacted] breathing seemed to accelerate as he watched a video [redacted]. [redacted] laughed nervously when articles concerning [redacted] were presented to him. [redacted] was visibly upset by photos of the victims recovered at the Pentagon crash site and people leaping from the World Trade Center. At the completion of the second interview, [redacted] while alone in the room, was seen with his head down on his hands on the table in front of him, crying.

For these interviews, the interview room was set up differently than past interviews. A long table was placed in front of [redacted] so as to present evidence in front of him. There was also a TV/VCR on the table along with binders, files and photographs. Upon entering the room and after greeting him, [redacted] commented he was surprised by all the things in the room. The interview agent offered [redacted] fruit, trail-mix and water. [redacted] accepted the water. It was explained to [redacted] the reason for all the items in the room was because the interview team was going to discuss with him many of the events which have happened in the world, since his arrest, and which affect him here in Guantanamo Bay. The interview agent reminded [redacted] he had promised him he would do this during the last interview. [redacted]

The interview agent said he did not have evidence against [redacted] he had hurt or killed anyone. He felt [redacted] like so many others, has been misled and manipulated, which makes him too a victim.

The interview agent explained, all these others are talking and cooperating, they are looking for their way out, saving their own butt, talking about him and implicating him deeper and deeper. [redacted] continued, they claim to know me by all these different names and have seen me in one place or another. The interview agent strongly told [redacted] torture is not an issue and he knows it. Further, when this goes before a tribunal, the torture argument will not be considered because the USG does not torture anyone in it's custody. He has to deal with this evidence and it's totality. [redacted] was told, it's highly improbable all these individuals huddled together to conspire against him, providing testimony which matches the other and which matches the photos [redacted]

The interview agent again pointed to the photo of [redacted] and stated, the pictures do not lie.

[redacted] was strongly told, torture is not an issue, isolation is no longer an issue, how the Koran is handled is no longer an issue. [redacted] has a much bigger issue to deal with right here and now, his future and his life.

The second interview began at 0400 the next morning. The photos and articles of [redacted] were laid out on the table in front of [redacted] for effect. The names of each was written on the dry-erase board [redacted] time-line was also written on the board. [redacted] was again offered fruit, trail-mix and water. He accepted the water. [redacted] began by bringing up the torture issue again and questioning the locations and names each provided. The interview agent told [redacted] torture was not an issue and he was not going to address it any longer. As for the rest, the interview agent told [redacted] attacking the minute aspects of what is presented is not going to discredit the totality of the case and evidence against him. This includes not just what was presented during the last interview but also his own admitted testimony and actions [redacted]

it would not be such a big deal and he would not be a major interest to investigators. However, he and the interview agent know that is not the case, that he was involved with a bad group of people, who looking back now, manipulated him. The interview agent told [redacted] he now wanted him to see and understand what the men laid out before him are responsible for. [redacted] was first shown video footage of the 9/11 attacks on the World Trade Center. [redacted] was then shown still photos of the towers on fire, planes crashing into the building, people leaping to their deaths and the collapse of the towers. [redacted] was then shown the burnt corpses of victims from the Pentagon attack. The interview agent told [redacted] these photos are very hard for him to look at and would be also for [redacted] however, he wanted [redacted] to know it was much harder to have to recover these people, as he did, following the day of the attack. [redacted] did look at the photos and was visibly upset by the photos. In prior interviews, [redacted] had refused to look at the photos.

[redacted] was asked if he thought this was something God would condone, was this in line with what Islam teaches. [redacted] solemnly stated no. [redacted] was asked if he felt this was something he felt was righteous in any way. He stated no. The interview agent pointed out to [redacted] those who hi-jacked the airplanes and knew they were going to die that day, committed suicide. He is aware that suicide is against Islam. Those who carried out this atrocity were not martyrs. A martyr is someone who dies bravely on the battlefield fighting an armed enemy where there is an exchange of fire. But someone who hi-jacks a plane full of innocent unarmed people, many of whom are women and children, and then crashes that plane into a building full of innocent unarmed people, they are not martyrs, they are murderers. They committed suicide. To commit such a horrific act in the name of Islam disgraces and defames the faith.

The interview agent pointed out to [redacted] the name of the towers included the word, "world" and of the 3000 human beings who were murdered that day, many were Muslims, Christians, Hindus, Jews, and people from many different countries. This was not an attack on any one country or any one group of people but an attack on all of humanity. No God, regardless of religion, would condone the murder of so many innocent unarmed people. Those who did this in the name of God and Islam, without a doubt, abuse and malign the religion and will feel God's wrath and anger on judgement day. Further, the interview team was already being told they may have to depart for another mission somewhere else in the near future. [redacted] was told, the interview team wanted to work with him but when they are told to leave, they must go, and they are unsure of when they will return. They hope that by that point, it is not too late. [redacted] was told, the interview team was going to give him a couple of days to think about everything they had presented to him and talked about. He needed to make a decision about his future and they hoped he makes the right one.
