

DETAILS

BASIS FOR INVESTIGATION: This office was notified by the 10<sup>th</sup> Military Police Battalion, U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command, Baghdad International Airport (BLAP) of four Iraqi Prisoners who were killed during a prison riot at the Abu Grihab Prison, Baghdad, IZ.

About 0800, 2 Dec 03, SA [redacted] b7C, b6-1 coordinated with SA [redacted] b7C-1, b6-1 Operations Officer, CJTF-7, Liaison, Camp Victory APO AE 09335. SA [redacted] provided the Serious Incident Report (SIR) detailing the synopsis of this b7C-1, b6-1 investigation. (See SIR for details)

About 1030, 2 Dec 03, SA [redacted] b7C, b6-1 interviewed LTC Jerry L. PHILLABAUM, [redacted] b7C, b6-4 Battalion Commander, 320<sup>th</sup> Military Police Battalion, Baghdad Correctional Facility (BCF), Abu Ghurayb, IZ. LTC PHILLABAUM stated during the prison riot his soldiers were exposed to violent rock and foreign objects being thrown. The detainees were anticipating release and were restless with the judicial process. LTC PHILLABAUM implemented Operation "Golden Spike", which was an emergency action plan for Prisoner Disturbance. LTC PHILLABAUM ordered Lethal Force be used after all actions of Non-Lethal means were exhausted. He based his decision on the safety of his soldiers and to maintain the prison integrity.

LTC PHILLABAUM provided copies of the Emergency Action Plan (EAP), 800<sup>th</sup> Military Police Brigade Rules for Engagement (ROE), and Scenario for Use of Force, (See EAP, ROE and Scenario forms for details)

About 110, 2 Dec 03, SA [redacted] b7C, b6-1 interviewed SFC [redacted] b7C, b6-4 320<sup>th</sup> Military Police Battalion, Abu Ghurayb, Baghdad, IZ APO AE 09335. SFC [redacted] stated he was the Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge of the shift and made numerous verbal attempts to the detainees to keep off the wire. SFC [redacted] stated he fired two or three Non-Lethal rounds at a crowd. The crowd immediately started pelting him with rocks and foreign objects. SFC [redacted] stated all posts were notified and he took cover in a guard tower for approximately 10 minutes from the flying rocks. The battalion re-supplied the guards with non-lethal rounds, but an assessment determined that Lethal force had to be used as the safety of soldiers, and that the facility needed to maintain security. SFC [redacted] stated he did not fire any lethal rounds at any prisoners. b7C-4, b6-4

About 1100, 4 Dec 03, SA [redacted] b7C, b6-1 coordinated with SPC [redacted] b7C, b6-4, 54<sup>th</sup> Quartermaster Company, Baghdad, IZ APO AE 09335 who provided the supporting certificates of death for the victims. Mr. SHAALAN cause of death was an apparent gunshot. Mr. SALMAN cause of death was from a gunshot wound to the face and skull. Mr. THAWIN was pronounced dead by CW4 [redacted] b7C-3, b6-3 Physician Assistant, 28<sup>th</sup> Combat Support Hospital (CSH), Baghdad, IZ. Mr. THAWIN cause of death was listed as gunshot wound to the chest. (See Certificate of Deaths for details)

About 1100, 2 Dec 03, SA <sup>b7C/b6-1</sup> [redacted] conducted a crime scene examination of Camp Ganci, Abu Ghurayb Prison, Baghdad, IZ MB 1272/8365.

CHARACTERISTICS OF SCENE: The Camp Ganci Prison area is located on a large internment facility. The facility is approximately 1 square mile. The Camp Ganci facility was approximately 800 feet long by 400 feet wide and contained eight (8) equally square sized detention fences. Each fenced in area contained approximately 550 prisoners. The facility had approximately 5,000 prisoners in the Camp Ganci Facility alone. There was three guard towers per each confined area.

CONDITION OF SCENE: At the time of the crime scene examination, the scene was wet. It had rained the last three nights previous to the incident. The ground was muddy and there was sufficient natural lighting in the area.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS: During the crime scene examination, the outside temperature was approximately 60 degrees Fahrenheit with overcast skies and wind factor. The area was muddy and Rocky

FACTORS PERTINENT TO ENTRY/EXIT (E/E): Access to the scene could be gained from all directions due to being in the middle of the compound. It is a foot accessible area and access into the individual confinement facility could be gained through only one manned entrance, which was guarded by armed personnel. There are also numerous roving guards in the Camp Ganci area in support of security operations.

SCENE DOCUMENTATION: SA <sup>b7C/b6-1</sup> [redacted] obtained a crime scene sketch of the scene from the 320 MP TOC. The sketch is an aerial layout of Camp Ganci. Photographs were exposed of the scene utilizing a Hewlett and Packert 320 Photo smart digital camera. (See crime scene sketch for details).

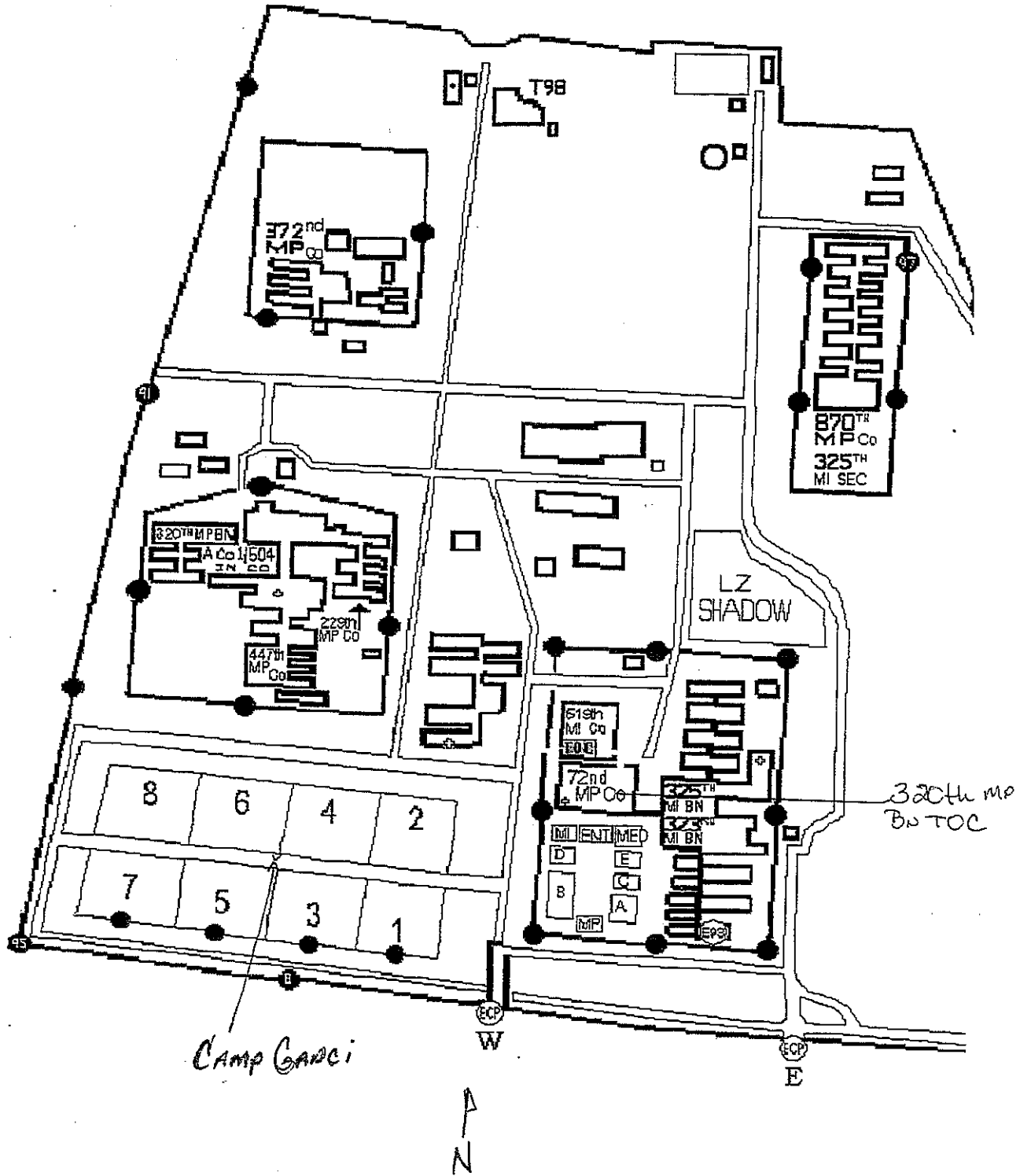
COLLECTION OF CRIME SCENE EVIDENCE: There was no evidence collected at the time of the examination due to the prisoners still inhabiting the crime scenes area. There was no determination as to which prisoner died in either confinement facility. The incident occurred on 24 Nov 03. CID Was dispatched to the scene on 2 Dec 03.

SEARCH FOR LATENT IMPRESSIONS: A search of latent prints was not conducted due to the circumstances of this investigation.

SEARCH BEYOND THE SCENE: A search beyond the crime scene was conducted, which met with positive results. There were signs of fresh rock, boulders, tent stakes and other foreign objects on the ground in the entire compound of Camp Ganci. Their where no objects in the towers as the soldiers had already removed all debris.

NEGATIVE EVIDENCE: There were no signs of negative evidence at the time of the examination. The prison was secure and evidence of humane surroundings. No mistreatment of prisoners was evident///LAST ENTRY///

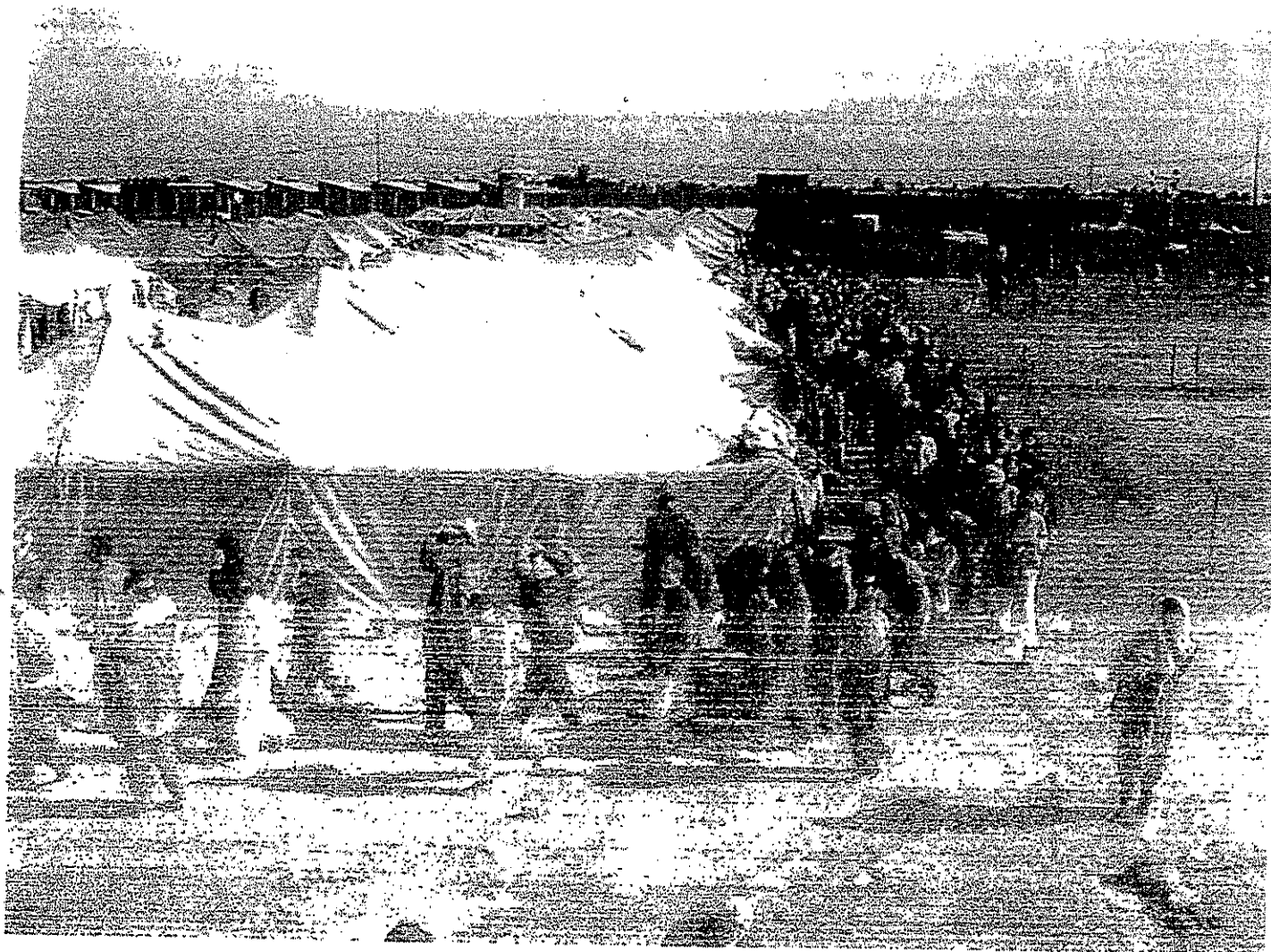

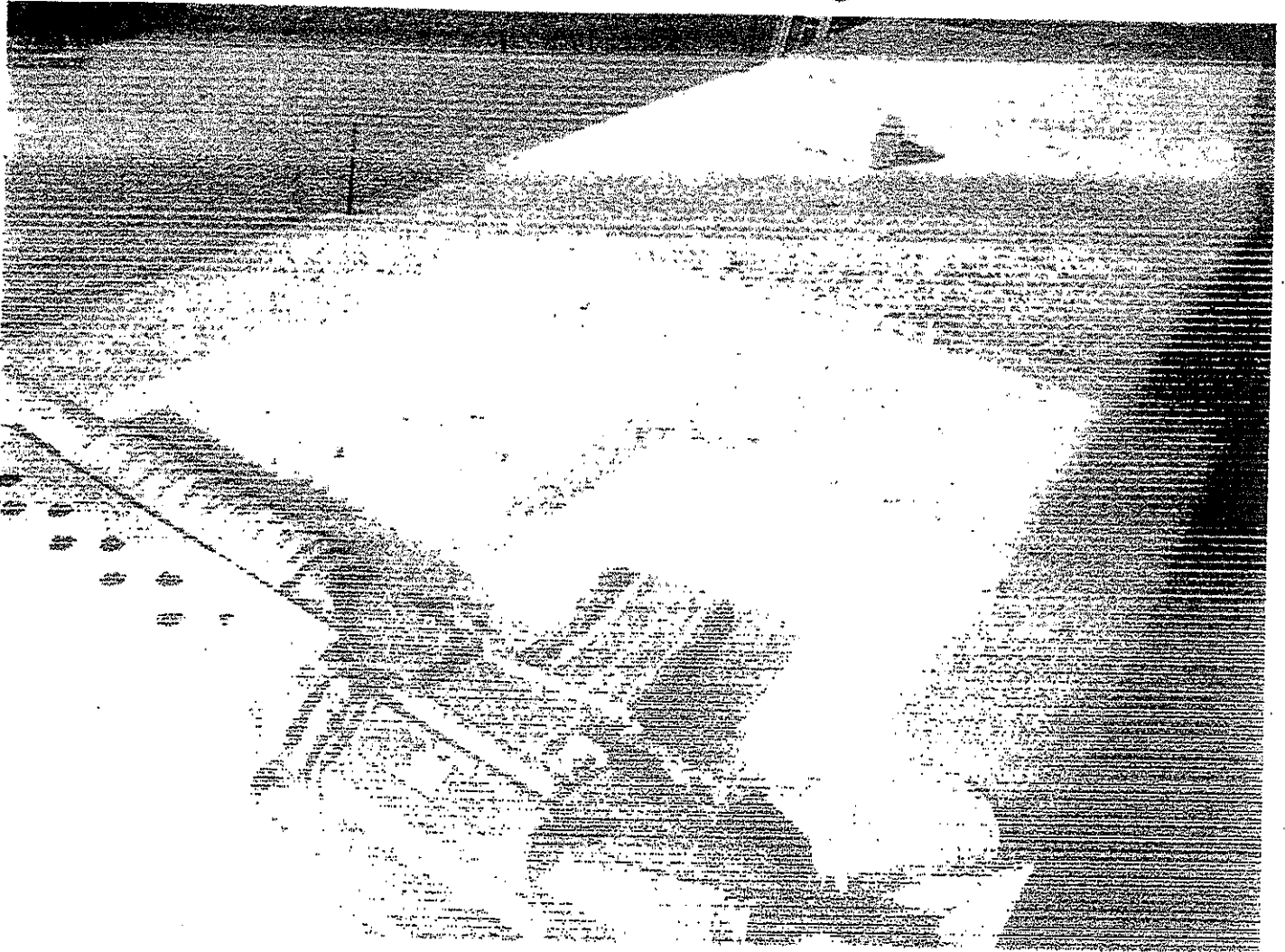

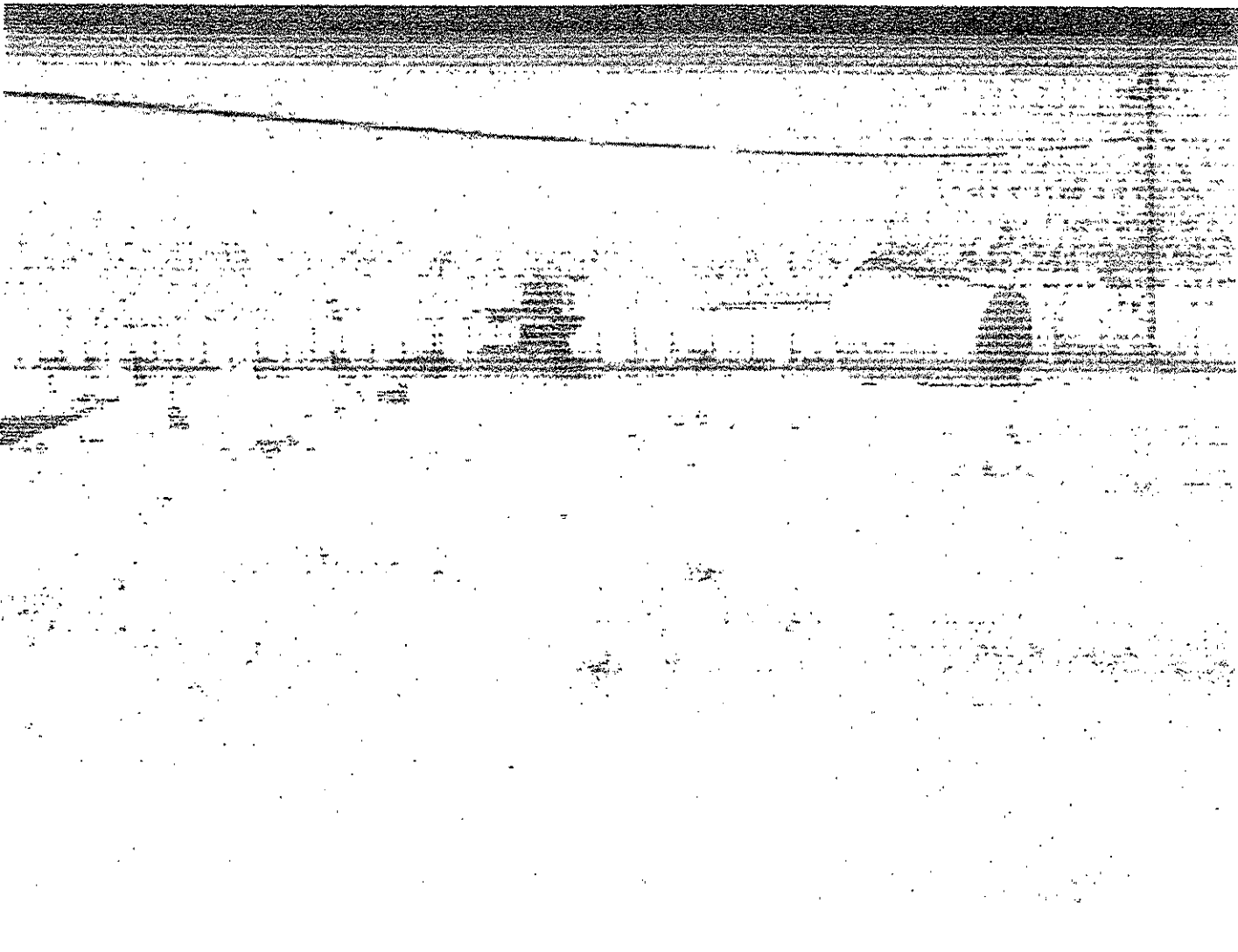

About 1330, 4 Dec 03, SA [redacted] Forensic Science Officer, 10th Military Police Battalion, Baghdad International Airport (BIAP), APO AE 09335, and SA [redacted] 12th MP Det (CID), BIAP, conducted an examination of three of the prisoners remains who were shot during the incident that occurred on 24 Nov 03, at the Abu Ghurayb Prison.

The first set of remains was that of an adult Caucasian male with black hair, a moustache and a beard. There was a toe identification tag bearing the name SALMAN, HUSSAYN A. There was a gunshot wound to the right side of the skull about 10cm by 5 cm. Parts of the Frontal and right Temporal bones were shattered. The skin was torn in a stellate pattern. There were no signs of powder residue or an abrasion collar on the edges of the wound. There were no apparent signs of another wound in the skull. The distal two phalanges of the index finger on the right hand were missing. The amputation appeared to be post mortem.

The second set of remains was that of an adult Caucasian male with black hair, a moustache and a beard. There was a toe identification tag bearing the name MAAZIN, THAWENE. There was a wound that had been sutured in the center of the chest about 20cm in length extending from the sternum towards the abdomen. There was a wound that had been sutured on the right lateral anterior side of the chest about 20cm in length extending from just below the right nipple towards the back. There were two sutured small wounds on the back above the right hip.

The third set of remains was that of an adult Caucasian male with black hair, a moustache and a beard. There was a toe identification tag bearing the name SHALAN, RAED. There was a tattoo on the right chest of a heart with two swords. There was a tattoo with Arabic writing on the right arm. There was a gunshot entrance wound to the lateral part of the upper left arm. It was obvious the left Humerus was broken. There was an exit wound to the anterior part of the upper left arm. The two wounds together appeared to be a perforating gunshot wound. There was an irregular entrance wound to the lateral portion of the left chest. These wounds were indicative of a gunshot wound going through the arm and re-entering the chest cavity.

At 1215, 6 Dec 03, SA [redacted] <sup>b7C-1, b6-1</sup> interviewed SGT [redacted] <sup>b7C-4, b6-4</sup> 870<sup>th</sup> Military Police Company, Pittsburgh, CA, who provided an Investigator's Statement regarding his actions during the prison riot on 24 Nov 03. SGT [redacted] related he fired three shots during the riot, hitting three prisoners. I, Jerry Lester Phillabaum, WANT TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT UNDER OATH:

On 24 November 2003 around 1300 hours, I was in the Life Support Area monitoring Motorola radio traffic. By getting spot reports from Camp Ganci, I realized that the situation was deteriorating and required additional forces. On my way to Camp Ganci, the riot broke out and I ordered execution of Golden Spike. Golden Spike is the plan used in response to a Camp Ganci wide riot where all military police units were assigned areas of responsibilities to control the riot and keep all prisoners within Camp Ganci compounds. As I walked the main runway, rocks were continuing to be thrown at MPs in the tower and in the runway. MPs on the ground were using non-lethal shotgun rounds to shot prisoners attempting to throw rocks. The prisoners were in the central part of each compound at a distance that was ineffective for non-lethal ammunition. As the prisoners advanced to throw rocks, the MPs would engage with non-lethal ammunition. Prisoners ignored all verbal commands to stop throwing rocks. After this rock throwing and non-lethal shotgun firing occurred throughout Camp Ganci compounds for ~~at~~ at

least 20 minutes, compounds began to report exhaustion of all non-lethal ammunition and requested authorization to use lethal force if the rock throwing continued. I granted approval to use lethal force, provided the Rules of Engagement (ROE) were followed with emphasis on well-aimed shots from the towers when soldiers felt threatened. Units on the ground sought confirmation of authorization to use lethal force, and I again provided the authorization with the limitation to comply with the ROE. As limited application of lethal force occurred, the rioting in the compounds ceased. Prisoners became more concerned with caring for their injured fellow prisoners than continuing the riot. MPs nervously allowed prisoners to carry wounded to the gate of the compound and then get away. This permitted medics to treat injuries appropriately. Bodies of those dead were expeditiously removed to calm the scene in the compound. After all injured prisoners were treated and removed from a given compound, the prisoners complied with orders to assemble so that a sweep of their tents could be made to look for weapons and so that accountability could be completely established. Later in the afternoon, the 800<sup>th</sup> MP Brigade entered information collected as to number of lethal rounds shot and type of weapon. To the best of my knowledge, all lethal rounds were fired from towers. 9mm pistols were not fired, nor were lethal rounds fired from shotguns.

Q. Were ROE's followed?

A. Yes.

Q. Was there previous intelligence that a riot was anticipated?

A. Yes, the CIA provided reports that Former Regime Loyalists were planning an attack to free high value detainees that they

Q. Do you have anything else to add to this statement?

A. On 4 November 2003, LTC [redacted] b7c-3, b6-3 who is the SJA of the 800th MP Bde gave instruction on revised rules of engagement. The instruction included scenarios to illustrate the response expected by the ROE. In followup discussion with LTC [redacted] b7c-3, b6-3, he determined that questions asked at the training were good and felt that my soldiers understood the ROE. In separate discussions with my soldiers, they all stated clear understanding of the revised ROE and their willingness to follow them.

"THIS IS AN OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM INVESTIGATION"

THIS OFFICE WAS NOTIFIED BY THE 10<sup>th</sup> MILITARY POLICE BATTALION (CID) (FWD), BAGHDAD, IRAQ, OF FOUR IRAQI PRISONERS KILLED DURING A PRISON RIOT AT THE ABU GHRAIB CORRECTION FACILITY.

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED COALITION GUARD FORCE PERSONNEL SHOT AND KILLED FOUR DETAINEES THAT WERE AGGRESSIVELY CONTRIBUTING TO A PRISONER RIOT. THE PRISONERS WOULD NOT COMPLY WITH ORDERED COMMANDS FROM GUARD FORCE PERSONNEL TO CEASE AND DESIST, AND WERE THREATENING TO AFFECT A BREACH OF THE CONTAINMENT PERIMETER.

PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION REVEALED DETAINEES IN COMPOUND FOUR AT CAMP GANCI INITIATED A DEMONSTRATION, PROTESTING CIRCUMSTANCES OF THEIR CAPTURE, JUDICIAL PROCEDURES, AND PRISONER RELEASE CONDITIONS. THE DETAINEES RALLIED BY YELLING, CHANTING AND INCITING OTHER COMPOUNDS TO BECOME NON-COMPLIANT WITH INSTITUTIONAL STANDARDS. AFTER SEVERAL MINUTES, THE DETAINEES TURNED VIOLENT AND STARTED THROWING ROCKS AT THE GUARDS. THIS INSTIGATED THE ADJACENT DETAINEE COMPOUNDS TO BEGIN RIOTING. IN COMPLIANCE WITH INSTITUTIONAL STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES GOVERNING RULES OF ENGAGEMENT, LESS-THAN-LETHAL FORCE WAS INITIALLY UTILIZED AGAINST THE RIOTERS. AFTER REPEATED, FAILED ATTEMPTS TO QUELL THE RIOTING, AUTHORIZATION WAS GRANTED TO EMPLOY LETHAL FORCE IN ORDER TO AFFECT ORDER AND DISCIPLINE WITHIN THE INSTITUTION. AT THIS TIME, ALL EIGHT CAMP GANCI PRISONER DETENTION COMPOUNDS WERE ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN VIOLENT AND AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR TOWARD US FORCES. AN ASSESSMENT OF THE SITUATION DETERMINED THAT A "MASS PRISON BREAK" WAS IMMINENT AND US FORCES WERE IN GRAVE DANGER DUE TO THE INEFFECTIVENESS AND DEPLETION OF LESS-THAN-LETHAL AMMUNITION STOCKS.

ABOUT 1335, 24 NOV 03, DEADLY FORCE WAS APPLIED AT COMPOUND FOUR. THE MOST IMMEDIATE THREAT WAS IDENTIFIED AND ENGAGED WITH SEVERAL AIMED SHOTS, RESULTING IN THE DEATH OF ONE DETAINEE AND MULTIPLE OTHERS WOUNDED. GUARDS AT COMPOUND

JUL 78

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SEVEN WERE NEXT TO APPLY DEADLY FORCE, WHICH RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF ONE DETAINEE. NO OTHER INJURIES WERE REPORTED. GUARDS AT COMPOUND ONE AND COMPOUND THREE FOLLOWED WITH THE USE OF DEADLY FORCE, RESULTING IN THE DEATH OF TWO DETAINEES. THESE USE OF FORCE ACTIONS DISRUPTED AND DEFUSED THE RIOTING TO AN EXTENT THAT ORDER WAS RESTORED AT 1347, 24 NOV 03, AND MEDICAL PERSONNEL COULD REACT TO THE INJURED.

MR. SALMAN, MR. SHAALAN, AND MR. SAYAR WERE PRONOUNCED DEAD AT THE SCENE BY LTC (DR) [REDACTED], 320<sup>TH</sup> MILITARY POLICE BATTALION, ABU GHRAIB PRISON. MR. SALMAN SUFFERED AN APPARENT GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE HEAD. MR. SHAALAN SUFFERED AN APPARENT GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE CHEST. MR. SAYAR SUFFERED AN APPARENT GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE ABDOMEN. LIFESAVING MEASURES WERE NOT PERFORMED ON THE DECEASED AT THE SCENE. MR. THAWIN WAS TRIAGED AT THE SCENE FOR A GUN SHOT WOUND TO THE CHEST, AND WAS ADMINISTERED INTRAVENOUS FLUIDS AND PRESSURE DRESSING TO THE CHEST. HE WAS EVACUATED TO THE 28<sup>TH</sup> COMBAT SUPPORT HOSPITAL, BAGHDAD, IZ, WHERE HE WAS LATER PRONOUNCED DEAD. THE IDENTITY OF THE PHYSICIAN OR APPLICABLE MEDICAL PERSONNEL PRONOUNCING MR. THAWIN DEAD WAS UNKNOWN AT THE WRITING OF THIS REPORT. b7c-3, b6-3
