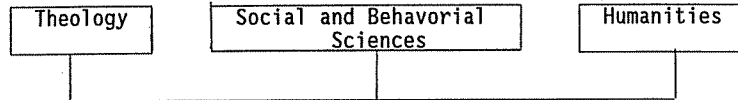

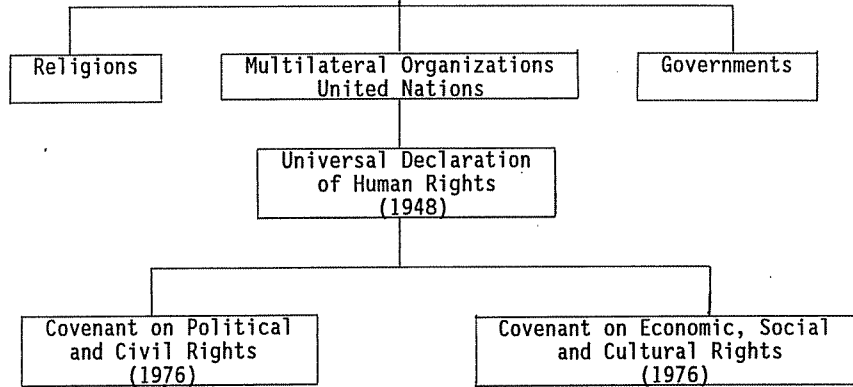
Three Levels of Work

I. SOCIAL THEORY

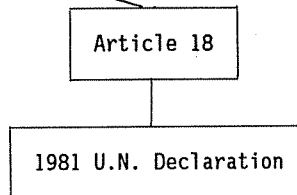


Objective:
To define an adequate and agreed upon general theory of human nature.

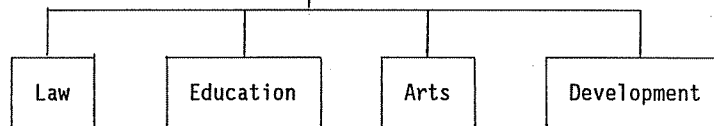
II. INTERNATIONAL LAW



Objective:
To develop a moral and legal framework of international law for redress of grievances that religions and governments will abide by.



III. LOCAL PROJECTS



Objective:
To build understanding and popular support through grassroots organizations and institutions at local levels that will encourage religions and governments to institute measures to implement Article 18 and the 1981 U.N. Declaration.
